APPLICATIONS:

1. A separate application form must be completed for each league in which your team(s) is (are) curling. Please enter all team member names, addresses and phone numbers and email addresses.
2. Please indicate a first and second league preference if you are registering for men's or mixed to assist in balancing the number of teams in each league.
3. Applications for the 2008-2009 season must be received at the St. Albert Curling Club no later than September 3rd, 2007. A cheque, dated no later than September 3rd, 2008 for the ENTIRE team fee must accompany the application. OR Two cheques in the amount of 50% of the total dated September 3rd, 2008 and a post-dated cheque 50% of the total for November 7th, 2008 **must accompany the application.** If the entire team fee is not enclosed, the application will not be accepted. Beginner's and Intermediate teams must submit one check for full amount. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE APPLICANT TO COLLECT THE DUES FROM TEAM MEMBERS.** Please make cheques payable to the St. Albert Curling Club.
4. If you wish to rent a locker please enclose a separate cheque of \$32.00 for each locker wanted.
5. Application forms and fees should be returned to the St. Albert Curling Club, 7 Sir Winston Churchill Avenue, St. Albert, AB, T8N 0G1 by Tuesday, September 3rd.
6. In addition to cheques and cash, Visa and Master Card payments are accepted however **in person only.**

ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS:

The following conditions will dictate acceptance of an application:

- 1) The application must comply with the points outlined above.
- 2) Applications will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis after giving consideration to the following Priorities of Acceptance.
 - a) A registered team name or four returning team members during the 2007-2008 season.
 - b) Three team members of the 2007-2008 team in the same Men's league. Any two members of a Mixed team in the same league. Three team members of the 2007-2008 team in the same Ladies' league
 - c) Registered team name or four returning team members in a comparable league during the 2007-2008 season.

- d) Three members of a 2007-2008 team, in a comparable Men's league. Two members of a 2007-2008 team, in a comparable Mixed league. Three team members of the 2007-2008 team in a comparable Ladies' league
 - e) Two members of a 2007-2008 team in the same Men's league. Two team members of a 2007-2008 team in the same Ladies' league
 - f) New applications from other existing leagues.
 - g) New applications to the club:
 - first preference given to St. Albert residents.
 - preference given to Sturgeon and District residents.
 - third preference given to Greater Edmonton area residents.
- 3) Applications received after September 3rd, 2008 will be accepted on a first-come basis.
