The Saturday Prospects' League will continue with 3 draws, with the 4:45pm draw designated as an intermediate league.

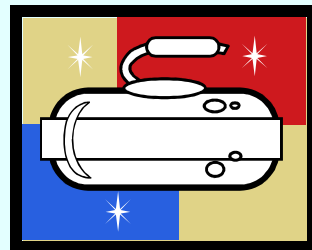
Those are the Rules
